the Museum is between Weybridge and Byfleet, just a few minutes from Junction 10 of the M25 and the A3 London to Portsmouth trunk road. Leave the A3 at the Painshill junction (A245) and follow the brown 'Brooklands Museum' signs. **Please note that due to major road works on the B365 diversions are in place for people accessing Weybridge. Visitors are advised to exit the A3 as above and follow the brown signs to Brooklands Museum.
